THIS PROGRAM STINKS! ODOUR IN ONTARIO

Odour has been an issue for industrial, manufacturing, agricultural and commercial/retail facilities (such as food services) for decades. As land use policies continue to encourage intensification or redevelopment within existing areas and as "greenfield" developments become less common, odour related conflicts between land users are starting to increase dramatically across Ontario. Our legal expert will address the framework surrounding odour in both the regulatory and common law context. Our two technical experts will share their views on how field sampling is conducted and how samples are assessed. They will also discuss the various modeling technologies available and positive and potentially negative concerns. They will comment on some of the various options to control odour, whether the source is industrial, municipal, agricultural or otherwise.
